My dog will not cause disturbances to other hotel guests at any point during their stay.

In accordance with Washington State Law RCW 49.60.215 and WAC 162-26-130 Ruby River Hotel welcomes trained service dogs and exempts them from dog fees. WA State Law states that failure to disclose animal training will result in the animal's disqualification from exemption.

Service animals are not exempt from expenses that result from damages caused by dog to hotel property. Under ADA regulations, Ruby River Hotel does not recognize any comfort, therapy, or companion dogs, untrained in a specific task to be exempt from the dog-cleaning fee.

Any dog that meets the qualifications of a service animal must be in the handler's control at all times to qualify for exemption.
